Level 2 Award & Diploma in Performing Arts

Introduction to the subject

This course is offered under the Wrexham 14-19 School Links Programme and is suitable for those wishing to develop their practical foundation level acting, singing and dance skills. You should therefore be open to developing an interest in all of these areas throughout the duration of the course.

Course Content

This course is made up of a variety of individual and group projects. You will develop your acting, vocal and movement skills. During the course there will be opportunities to take part in a performance. Teamwork plays a vital part of the course and you will create performance material as part of your group work.

This two year course is made up of 9 units which cover a range of skills required for the Performing arts Industry.

Assessment

This qualification is made up of practical assessments which are supported by theoretical work to underpin the skills you will learn. It will be internally assessed, and then moderated by the exam board.

Career Opportunities

On completion of this course, you are unlikely to progress directly into a related area of employment. However, you may wish to audition for a Level 3 qualification in Performing Arts in order to continue developing your skills and knowledge as a performer.

You will need to wear suitable black clothing for all sessions.
