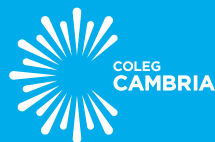

FEES AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Fees shown cover up to the first year of study only. For two or three year courses, the same fee will be payable again at the start of your second and third years of study.

You will need a letter of agreement to pay or a purchase order if your company is paying your course fee.

YOU CAN PAY BY:

- Cash
- Cheque
- Credit or Debit Card
- Employer's Purchase Order

Course fees over £400 are eligible for instalments - learners pay 25% at enrolment and three subsequent direct debit payments of 25%

Where the course duration is 10 weeks or fewer, students must pay in full at the time of enrolment.

Any deferred payment plans must be agreed and signed for by the student and college staff prior to enrolling and starting classes.

Instalments are not available for learners that have been withdrawn for non-payment of fees.

What is an Apprenticeship?



Apprenticeships give you the opportunity to work for an employer, earn a salary, get paid holidays and achieve nationally recognised qualifications. You will also gain valuable workplace skills and experience.

Apprenticeships are for ages 16 and over and for people already employed, subject to eligibility criteria. They develop your knowledge and practical ability to do your job effectively and by being employed you are developing employability skills and personal confidence. Apprenticeships are a great way to start and develop your career and open the door to exciting employment prospects.

- **Earn a wage**
- **Gain recognised qualifications**
- **Get on-the-job training and skills**

The Welsh Government supports an all age apprenticeship programme, therefore you could be eligible for an apprenticeship opportunity to train, regardless of age or job title.

Cambria works with a wide range of employers to support apprenticeships from Level 2 - Level 6 in over 400 different pathways, for a wide variety of sectors.

There are five levels of apprenticeships which take between 1-4 years to complete individually (more if progressing through the levels). You will gain industry approved qualifications, extensive work experience and qualifications within literacy, numeracy and digital literacy (for specific courses).

ReAct+ offers tailored support to those trying to re-enter the labour market by removing barriers and providing grant support for vocational training, travel costs and care (including childcare) related to training.

ReAct+ is a grant programme that builds on the success of previous programmes and contributes to the Welsh Government's Young Person's Guarantee.

What support is available?

- Vocational training grant of up to £1,500
- An Extra Support grant, to help with expenses such as travel and accommodation up to £200
- Help with registered care and childcare costs while training up to £2,100

Eligibility

To be eligible for ReAct+ support you must be aged 20 years old and over, live in Wales and one of the following:

- Under formal notice of redundancy
- Made redundant within the last 6 months
- Customers in the secure estate (prison)
- An ex-offender released within the last 6 months
- An offender serving their sentence in the community - funding is only eligible for courses taking place within the first 6 months of their sentence
