Our full-time HND fees for 27/28 will be in line with the Welsh Government's fee level and subject to any changes in that limit. Our full-time HND fees are £5000 per course per academic year.

Qualifications and location of qualifications:

The full-time HND fee is £5,000 per course per academic year. Available subjects comprise *Esports* at the **Deeside** campus, *Hospitality* at the **Yale** campus, and *Animal Management* at the **Northop** campus.

Section 1.2 - Aggregate fee levels

Coleg Cambria is committed to providing absolute clarity regarding the total cost of study. To ensure a comprehensive and transparent overview, the following breakdown outlines the total aggregate sums of fees and charges incurred by students in connection with our full-time higher education courses:

1. Aggregate Higher National Certificate (HNC) Fees

- **Tuition Fees:** The full-time HNC tuition fee for the 2027/28 academic year is **£5,000 per course**. This fee level aligns with the Welsh Government’s statutory fee limits and remains subject to any changes made to that limit.
- **Total Aggregate HNC Costs:** The total aggregate full-time HNC fees and core charges incurred by a student in connection with their course for the academic year are **£5,000**.

2. Aggregate Higher National Diploma (HND) Fees

- **Tuition Fees:** The full-time HND tuition fee for the 2027/28 academic year is **£5,000 per course, per academic year**. Like the HNC, this is in line with the Welsh Government's prescribed fee level and any subsequent changes to that limit.
- **Total Aggregate HND Costs:** The total aggregate full-time HND fees incurred by a student over the full duration of their two-year programme of study are **£10,000** (£5,000 per academic year).

3. Scope of the Aggregate Sums

- **Comprehensive Overview:** The figures of £5,000 (HNC) and £10,000 (HND) represent the comprehensive total sum of all core fees and charges required to complete these qualifications.
- **Additional Course Costs:** In accordance with institutional commitments, any necessary additional course-related costs (such as essential materials or specific field trips) are explicitly detailed and provided in highly accessible, external formats, including specific course webpages and formal offer letters, ensuring students face no unexpected financial outlays.

Coleg Cambria is committed to ensuring absolute transparency, clarity, and fairness regarding tuition fees and any potential future amendments. Whilst the current Fee Limit Statement is publicly accessible on our website, the college employs structured, proactive mechanisms and strict timescales to ensure all prospective and current students are fully informed of any changes.

The communication strategy relies on the following mechanisms and timelines:

- **Pre-Enrolment and Prospective Students:** Any adjustments to fee structures are updated on the college website and digital prospectus immediately upon approval. For applicants holding offers, direct notifications are sent via email or the applicant portal. This occurs at the earliest opportunity, ensuring students have a minimum of three months' notice prior to the start of their course to make informed financial decisions.
- **Current and Continuing Students:** In the rare event that a fee amendment affects continuing students (subject to legislative changes or pre-agreed inflationary adjustments outlined in the initial student agreement), the college utilizes a multi-channel approach. This includes:
 - **Direct Digital Communication:** Personalised emails sent directly to student accounts.

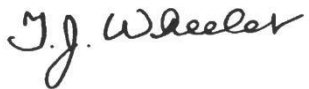
- The Student Portal: Targeted notifications on the internal Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) / Student Dashboard.
- Student Voice Channels: Briefings shared with Student Representatives and the Student Voice forum to ensure peer-to-peer support and clarity.
- **Timescales for Communication:** For any amendments affecting an ongoing or upcoming academic year, Coleg Cambria enforces a minimum notification period of one full term (approximately 12 weeks) before the change takes effect. This ensures students have ample time to discuss funding arrangements with Student Finance Wales (or relevant funding bodies) and the college's Student Support and Financial Advice teams.
- **Support and Advice:** All communications regarding fee amendments explicitly direct students to the college's dedicated financial support services. This ensures that any student requiring guidance on bursaries, scholarships, or payment plans receives tailored, one-to-one assistance to mitigate the impact of any changes.

Through these robust channels, Coleg Cambria ensures that no student faces unexpected financial adjustments and that all communications comply fully with consumer protection legislation and Medr's regulatory expectations.
